FIRST: A meeting of THE MUSLIMS OF AMERICA, an unincorporated independent religious body was duly called and held in conformity with said article of the Religious Corporation Law, at which meeting a majority of the duly qualified voters, being at least six in number, were present.

SECOND: Said meeting decided that said religious body should become incorporated to engage in any lawful act or activity for which a corporation may be organized under the Religious Corporation Law.

THIRD: The name or title by which said corporation shall be known in law shall be THE MUSLIMS OF AMERICA, INC.

FOURTH: The principal place of worship shall be located at 2732 Roods Creek Road, Hancock, New York, 13783.

FIFTH: The number of Trustees of said corporation shall be three.

The Petition of Hussein Adams and Khadijah Smith, by their attorney, Tahirah H. Clark,
respectfully shows:

1. Your petitioners constitute a majority of the trustees of Muslims of the Americas, Inc. (hereinafter MOA), a religious corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York, and located in the County of Delaware, and your petitioners all reside in said County.
2. Said Corporation has ceased to act in its corporate capacity.
3. Your petitioners therefore pray for an Order of this Court dissolving said corporation for the following facts, reasons or causes:
 - a. A recent investigation was commenced by the current leadership of MOA. The leadership compiled and reviewed all legal paperwork establishing MOA dating back to the early 1980s. It became evident that the incorporation papers, namely an amendment of incorporation (annexed hereto as Exhibit A), was fraudulently prepared and recorded. This was all unbeknownst to the members of MOA and the trustees at the time and subsequently.
 - b. The so-called amendment actually changed the corporate name of another organization which was involved in questionable activity. The result of the amendment was that MOA had, in 1985, legally assumed this corporation called,

Ikhwanul Muslimun, Inc. (hereinafter IM) headquartered in Brooklyn in the County of Kings.

- c. The entire incorporation filing stemming from the amendment was fraudulent as it identifies a fictitious board of trustees, signatures and dishonest notary attestation.
- d. In order to understand the devastating significance of findings one must go back approximately 32 years to the beginning of the formation of MOA.
- e. The Wahabis established IM in America in order to influence and control the American Muslims with their controversial ideology. Their aim was to direct American Muslims towards Wahabism as opposed to true Islam.
- f. In the early 1980's, disenchanted with the overall direction the community was going Yahya A. Kareem, Imam and Trustee of IM, along with hundreds of its members decided to follow the spiritual guidance of another Imam.
- g. Under this new spiritual leadership, Muslims of the Americas, an unincorporated religious corporation was formed.
- h. After Mr. Kareem's departure from IM, the membership split, the majority following him, while others went their separate ways.
- i. Ikhwanul Muslimun, Inc., ceased to both function in its corporate capacity and keep up religious services.
- j. At that time the goal of the MOA trustees and congregation was to initiate a brand new organization which reflected its values of self-sufficiency and peacefulness and completely sever all ties and association with IM.
- k. Instead a group of cunning members who falsely presented themselves as proponents of the new community created a Trojan horse by linking MOA's legal status with the negative history of IM.
- l. Muhammad Hasib Abdul-Haqq, a formerly trusted member of MOA, forged the signature of Mubarak Ali Shah [Gilani], listing him as President of MOA. Mr. Gilani, the Spiritual Leader of MOA was not even present in the country at the time. Mr. Abdul-Haqq was not legally authorized to act on his behalf. In fact, another member, Muhammad Atiq A. Shahid had been chosen by overwhelming vote as President of the corporation. (Exhibit B)

- m. This scheme was executed with the assistance of a now disbarred New York attorney named Anis A. Siddiqi at the direction of Mr. Abdul-Haqq who had served as the keeper of the record and respected advisor for MOA for over 30 years.
- n. Based on the above, MOA trustees have voted to completely dissolve the corporation make public its findings and begin anew as was originally intended.
- o. To this end, The Muslims of America, (TMOA) has been newly incorporated pursuant to the NYS Religious Corporation Law. (Exhibit C)

4. The situation and description of real property owned by Petitioner is as follows:

a. Hereinafter known as Holy Islamberg, located at 2732 Roods Creek Road, Hancock, New York, 13783. All that tract or parcel of land situate in the Town of Tompkins, Delaware County, New York State, being the same premises described in Deed Liber 716 at Page 315.

b. Hereinafter known as Maryamville located at Maryamville Road, Hancock, NY, 13783. All that tract or parcel of land, situate in the town of Deposit, (formerly a part of the Town of Tompkins) in the County of Delaware and state of New York, being same premises as described in Deed Liber 902 at Page 156.

5. The full market value of Holy Islamberg is approximately \$403,000.00.

6. The full market value of Maryamville is approximately \$145,000.00.

7. The market values of both Holy Islamberg and Maryamville originated from the Delaware County Final Tax Roll for 2012.

8. Said Corporation has no debts or liabilities.

9. Petitioners propose to transfer and convey Holy Islamberg and Maryamville to the following Religious Corporation: The Muslims of America, Inc.

10. Notice of the time and place of this application been duly published once in each week for at least four weeks successively next preceding this application, in The Hancock Herald, a newspaper published in the County of Delaware, where said corporation is located, as appears by the proof of publication annexed hereto as "Exhibit D".

11. A majority of the Trustees of said corporation duly approved of the dissolution thereof, and of this application, at a meeting of said corporation duly called and held on January 6, 2013.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray that this Court may order and decree the dissolution of said religious corporation, Muslims of the Americas, Inc. (MOA), and for that purpose order and direct a conveyance of all real property belonging to such corporation by deed, to The Muslims of America, Inc. (TMOA); and that your Petitioners have such other and further order and decree in the premises as may be just and proper.



AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF PETITION FOR DISSOLUTION


To the Supreme Court of the State of New York
County of Delaware

I, Muhammad Hasib Abdul- Haqq, being over the age of majority and duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. During the 1970s and up to and including the 1980s, I lived in Brooklyn East New York in the County of Kings. From the mid-1980s and currently, I live in upstate New York.
2. In the 1970s, I was part of a large Muslim community in Brooklyn called Dar ul Islam. Our congregation consisted of mostly African American families who had converted from different branches of Christianity and into the religion of Islam as Sunni Muslims.
3. By the late 1970s, there was a growing divide within the community. Some of the conflict in the group resulted in gang-like street violence.
4. In 1974, I served as book keeper for Dar ul Islam.
5. A growing and vocal majority of the members desired to practice Islam in a more traditional way. They yearned for religious nurturing and peace. They desired to separate themselves from the upheaval in the inner-city which was occurring in the Dar ul Islam community. My family and I were a part of this majority.
6. It was with a commitment to these principles, that Muslims of America (hereinafter MOA) was formed in 1979. It was initially formed as an unincorporated religious organization. It became popular and people fell in love with the new leadership and the opportunity for peacefulness and happiness.
7. The people had chosen Muhammad Atiq A. Shahid to head the congregation. El Sheik Mubarik Gilani was a spiritual mentor for MOA.

8. The developing community thrived. The membership was optimistic as it embarked on a fresh start. It had no loyalties to any other political, religious or social group. In fact, over the years, members and leaders took great pride in forming a positive identity under the banner of MOA.
9. Members of MOA purchased property in rural Upstate New York. The men, women and children enrolled in classes to learn gardening, homeownership techniques, landscaping and other skills of self-sufficiency. They exercised their skill in cultivating the land which they had purchased.
10. From the legal perspective, I was appointed to facilitate the establishment of the incorporation of MOA. It was clear that MOA was to have a particular set of trustees and to have been developed as a brand new organization.
11. The MOA leadership engaged a lawyer to draft all of the documents as described above.
12. However, instead of carrying out the plan agreed upon by the masses, I hired a lawyer unknown to the people and directed that lawyer to prepare documents resulting in MOA's legally assuming a group called Ikhwanul Muslimun, Inc. (Hereinafter IM). This group was a little known branch of the Dar ul Islam in Brooklyn and was a subsidiary, so-to-speak of Dar ul Islam.
13. This group surfaced sometime in the 1960s, and pre-dates El Sheik Gilani's arrival in the United States. I was familiar with it as the book keeper, but most people would know nothing about it.
14. IM had already been established as an incorporated religious organization. Its legal standing was solidified.
15. I understood that IM did not have any usefulness once the divide between the Muslims of Dar ul Islam occurred. Therefore, I unilaterally made an unwise and dishonest decision that I have lived to regret.
16. I knew that IM would be dormant after the split, and I decided that we could use it by conducting a legal name change from Ikhwanul Muslimun, Inc. to Muslims of America. Therefore I arranged for an amendment to the incorporation documents of IM to be prepared reflecting those intentions. In so doing, I created a fictitious board and executed the names trustees on the founding documents.
17. One of the names I counterfeited was the name of El Sheik Gilani as the president of the surviving organization. The lawyer that I engaged then illegally notarized the documents and recorded them with the authorities. That lawyer has since been disbarred for other acts of dishonesty.
18. At no time did I have the permission – either implicit or explicit – to sign the name, of El Sheik Gilani to these documents.
19. The end result of the filing was that Ikhwanul Muslimun, Inc. was now known as Muslims of America, Inc. This was only a name change, not a brand new entity as desired by the people. Additionally, it meant that MOA had now married an organization with dangerous baggage.

20. At the time, I knew that what I was doing was dishonest, but I did not completely appreciate that Ikhwanul Muslimun, Inc. was linked to international criminal activity. I had no idea that was the case.
21. I thought what I was doing was in the best interest of MOA since it was less expensive and quicker than the alternative.
22. Over the years, it started to become apparent to me that I had made a grave mistake. However, I felt too ashamed to tell anyone of what had happened or to explain the significance of what had happened to those without the background knowledge to understand it.
23. I came to realize that Ikhwanul Muslimun, Inc. was established by Saudi Arabian Wahabis who desired to secure the following of the inner city Muslims during their transformation in the late in 1970s. The Wahabis had plans to mislead the American Muslims with whom they built relationships.
24. Fortunately, the members of MOA were not at all influenced by this group. The positivity surrounding MOA was strong enough to override any negative influence.
25. I did what I thought was best for the community at the time. At no time did I intend to put the community or El Sheik Gilani in such a compromising situation. I am sorry and beg for forgiveness from Allah, El Sheik and the community as a whole.
